

Appendix 2 to SWOA AGM 2010 Minutes

Fixture Secretary's Report

There were 178 registered events in the period 01 September 2009 to 31 August 2010, compared to 146 in 200/2009. This is the first complete year using the new online fixtures database and the 2009/2010 totals will include events that would have previously been registered on the old ER1P or ER1C forms. The apparent increase in the annual total of events is consistent with previous years if these events are added to previous years totals.

Looking back over the year DEVON hosted the Caddihoe Chase and South West Championships on Hound Tor & Haytor in September, NGOC hosted the Southern Championships on Lydney Park in February, and UBOC hosted the British Universities and Colleges Sport (BUCS) Orienteering Championships on Sallowvallets and Stock Hill in March. SWOA hosted JK in early April, starting with the sprint race at Bicton College and the first individual day on Cookworthy, and finishing with the second individual race and the JK Relays on Braunton Burrows. There were 8 other classic regional events (WSX Bisterne South, QO Croydon Hill, SARUM Grovely East, WIM Cranesmoor, BOK Wavering Down, and KERNO & DEVON Tamar Triple on Penhale). There were also 9 SWOA Galoppen League events. The season ended with a series of 6 Relay events.

We have started the 2010/2011 season with the SWOA Sprint Champs, and WSX are hosting Caddihoe on Wareham Forest later in September. WIM are hosting the Southern Night Champs in late November, and SARUM are hosting a Compass Sport Cup Round 1 in January. BOK are hosting the South West Middle Champs as part of their Double O Severn in early April. There are another 5 classic regional events in the planner, and 9 Galoppen League events. DEVON will be hosting Caddihoe 2011, and SARUM will be hosting the British Night Champs in February 2012.
