South West Junior Squad Report 2013.

This year has been one of transition for the squad with a large number of juniors moving on and many beginning their involvement with the squad. The epicentre of the squad has shifted over the last few years to become more centred on Bristol and Devon which is a reflection of the amount of time and effort both these clubs are expending on junior orienteering.

The past year has seen three days during the October half term running an event on behalf of the Army then training on southern terrain in preparation for the 2013 JK. The Christmas weekend was held at Bulford Ridge and Tidworth in December on the same weekend as the Yvette Baker Trophy Final where a number of squad members ran in the victorious Bristol team.

One day was spent on the track at Bath early in September but a follow up weekend in January had to be cancelled due to snow.

I would like to particularly thank Arthur and Christine Vince for their assistance in feeding the squad over the last few years. They retired from this role at our October half term training last year.
