### **Appendix 1 to Minutes: FIXTURES REPORT**

There were 196 SWOA registered events in the period 01 September 2010 to 31 August 2011, compared to 178 in 2009/2010. This is the second complete year using the new online fixtures database so that comparing the totals should be valid.

Looking back over the year DEVON hosted the South West Sprint Champs on Exeter University on 12 September. WESSEX hosted the Caddihoe Chase and South West Long Championships on Wareham Forest at the end of September. WIM staged the Southern Night Champs on Washers Pit on a very cold night at the end of November. SARUM hosted a joint SWOA/SCOA Compass Sport Cup Round 1 in January, and BOK hosted the SWOA Middle Champs on Stock Hill as a warm up for the Mike Nelson BOKTrot in early April. There were 3 other classic regional events (NGOC Knockalls Inclosure, WIM Brownhill Inclosure, and SARUM Great Ridge), and 9 SWOA Galoppen League events. The season ended with a series of 6 Relay events.

We started the 2011/2012 season with the Caddihoe Chase and South West Long Champs on Burrator. WIM have just hosted the South West Sprint Champs. DEVON are hosting a Compass Sport Cup Round 1 in February. There are another 4 level B events in the planner, and 9 Galoppen League events. SARUM will be hosting the British Night Champs in February 2012. DEVON and KERNO are hosting a four day Tamar Jubilee in early June, and SARUM will be hosting Caddihoe in September 2012. BOK will be hosting the Compass Sport Cup Final in 2013 and the Senior Home International in 2014. KERNO are hosting the Southern Champs on Penhale in April 2013.

### **Appendix 2 to Minutes: JUNIOR ORIENTEERING SQUAD REPORT**

A successful year for the squad with an excellent 5<sup>th</sup> place performance at the Junior Inter Regional Championships in the Lake District at the end of June.
